Call to Public

DDD Staff Updates

Jeffrey Yamamoto announced from the DDD COVID-19 webpage from 1/11/2022.

- 46,672 members being served by DDD
 - 41,588 members are living in their own home/family home
 - o 5,084 members are living in licensed facilities
- 4,484 members tested positive for COVID-19
 - 2,992 residing in their own/family home
 - 1,492 residing in licensed facilities
- 88 Member deaths attributed to COVID-19 (41 lived in a family/own home & 47 lived in licensed facilities).
- Tracking weekly counts, Data above is from 1/11/2022
- Jeffrey also included the following information



- CDC has approved the Pfizer booster for children older than five.
- The Public Health Emergency (PHE) has been extended by the Health and Human Services Department to Mid-January and the DDD flexibilities tied to the PHE continue through that time including Home Delivered Meals and Parents as paid direct care workers for their minor children.
- AHCCCS did submit their proposal to the Centers for Medicare/Medicaid Service (CMS) for using the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds. AHCCCS is waiting on the AZ legislature to reconvene and approve the AZ funding side of the ARPA funds. DDD hopes that the approval will be completed by early springtime frame.
- Jeffrey also included the following information.
 - New redactor is being trained and the full-time redactor is out. The IR to be posted may be delayed for about 4 days.
 - The DDD Quarterly District IOC meeting is on Wednesday Jan 19th, one week from the day of this meeting, at 10:00am. If anyone is interested, please leave it in the chat
