- We're having meetings this month to discuss with different stakeholders



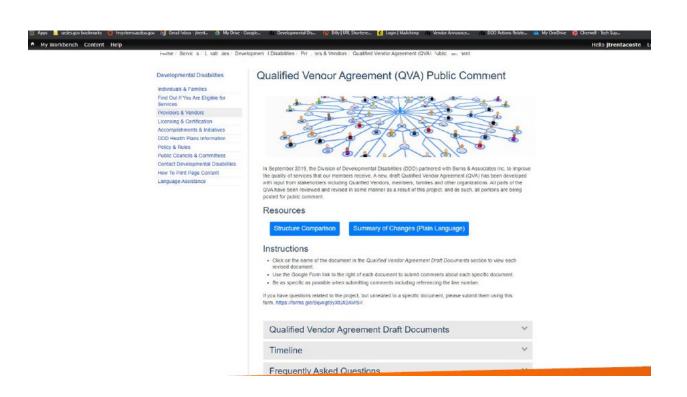

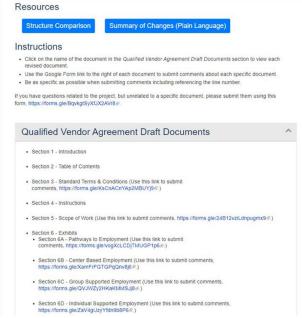

#### Nicolette Fidel Finished her presentation.

**Bob Malloy** asked about the pay rate being paid to the Direct Care Workers. Nicolette responded that unfortunately the Vendor sets the actual rate for their own contractors.

**Sandy Malloy** asked about making COVID-19 vaccination mandatory for vendors. Nicolette mentioned the Governors Executive Orders prevents this from happening.

**Leah Gibbs** from DDD OIFA updated the committee on COVID-19 and DDD.

- 45,040 members being served by DDD
- 2,792 members tested positive for COVID-19
- 74 Member deaths attributed to COVID-19, No deaths for last two months
- Tracking weekly. January was high of positivity, now single digits
- Support Coordinators are making contact and informing the members on all the flexible COVID-19 benefits which are available for them
- Over half of members are vaccinated. Still encourage members and families for vaccinations

**Marylin Croci** asked if the committee wanted the Planning Documents with the Behavior Plans. She hadn't been from before with Cynthia as chair. This will be discussed later in Executive Session.

**Jennifer Myler** stated that DN has 3939 members. Mohave and Yavapai area offices have added two new employees each to serve.



Staci Rodarmel didn't have anything to update.

Michelle Pollard included that NCI is working with the Provider Survey also to gain more information.

#### **Updates from ADOA**

Larry Allen: Larry mentioned about ADOA and OIFA trying to create more volunteer interest.

**Bob Malloy** mentioned that some of the district members are not happy to be meeting virtually and may quit because of it. **Larry Allen** Responded that accommodation will be available to the members. Virtual will help with the geographically large area. **Jennifer Myler** noted that DN covers 64% geographically AZ but only has 4000 members.

#### **Updates from the Health Care plans**

There was no participation from the Health Care Plan for this meeting.

#### **DDD IOC Liaison Updates**

**Jeffrey Yamamoto** informed the committee that the Tribal Liaison presentation is set up for April 27<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 during the District West IOC Meeting. All of the District North members were invited by email and calendar invitations.

**Jeffrey Yamamoto** also informed the committee before the start of the meeting that Maegan Van Wyck had resigned just before the meeting.
