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# QM Portal Incident, Accident and Death Reports (IAD) and Quality of Care Concern (QOC) process

- The QM Portal was designed to allow for direct provider input allowing for real time entry, investigation and follow up on Incident Accident and Death Reports (IAD).
- IAD process:
  - o Providers from all types of treatment facilities log into the system and submit reports within the Portal.
  - A Provider Agency Quality Management staff and/or Provider Agency Director reviews, follows up on and signs off on the report including notes on any action taken or follow up on a members current condition.
  - o The Health Plan completes their required Quality Management, tracking and trending process including the Quality Of Care (QOC) process.
  - o The AHCCCS Quality Management team reviews the Health Plan reports and follow up as needed.
  - o The Health Plans are responsible for removing all Personally Identifying Information (PII) from the reports and uploading them for IOC review as the reports are finalized.



# QM Portal Seclusion and Restraint (SAR) reporting process


 The QM Portal Seclusion and Restraint reporting application was designed to allow for direct Health Plan input allowing for real time entry, investigation and follow up on incidents of seclusion and/or restraint.

#### • SAR process:

- o SAR individual reports are completed at the treatment facility, Hospital, Sub Acute, Observation units, etc., in compliance with Arizona Administrative Code R9-10-217 and 225 and reviewed by the Provider Agency prior to being forwarded to the Health Plan
- o The Health Plan is required to enter certain information from each report into the QM Portal SAR application as a part of their Quality management, tracking and trending process.
- o The Health Plans are responsible for removing all Personally Identifying Information (PII) from the reports and uploading them for IOC review as the reports are finalized.


#### Statutory Notification

Subject to federal law, committee members and consultants have access to client information and records maintained by the appropriate department, provider or regional behavioral health authorities to the extent necessary to conduct committee duties. Each person who receives information or records pursuant to this subsection shall maintain the information or records as confidential and sign an agreement to comply with all confidentiality requirements. Any client information or records shall be released to the committee without the designation of personally identifiable information unless the personally identifiable information is required for the afficial purposes of the committee. "Personally identifiable information" includes name, address, date of birth, social security number, tribal enrollment number, telephone or telefacsimile number, driver license number, places of employment or school identification or military identification number or any other distinguishing characteristic that tends to identify a particular person. A violation of this subsection is a class 2 misdemeanor (A.R.S. 41-3804)

- •Select the maximum reports you'd like to see




#### **IOC QM Portal Search Feature Details**

- Incident Date requires 2 digit month, 2 digit date and 4 digit year
- Document Date requires 2 digit month, 2 digit date and 4 digit year
- Provider requires at least the first name, e.g. La will generate La Frontera. It is important to note that not all provider names match the operating name used in the community. Provider names are linked to the original provider registration with AHCCCS.
- IOC Committee will be locked to the committee that the user is a member of
- Category is a drop down feature that allows member to select one the five selections
- Status is a drop down that allows the members the option to view only the reports that have not been reviewed or those who already have been reviewed. *Note:* When you are reviewing you will need to check the reviewed box so that other members are able to see that you have completed the review (not automatic) or all reports will appear unreviewed.
- Allegation is a drop down that allows the members to search by one of fifteen specific allegations listed
- Max is a drop down that allows members to review up to 250 reports at one time based on the selected quantity, default is always set at 25
- IAD Number allows members to search by IAD number, it must be entered in this format in order to work appropriately e.g. IAD-2019-1234
- Order by is a drop down feature that allows members to search in ascending and descending order








## **IOC QM Portal Export to Excel**






### IOC QM Portal Export reports to excel



The report has many more columns than are shown here and can easily be sorted by health plan, provider, incident type and any other category you would like to track or trend.




#### **IOC QM Portal Open and Review Reports**







## **IOC QM Portal View Member IAD history**






## **IOC QM Portal Inquiry Form**
