Vera Kramarchuk (Mercy Care Ombudsman) shared that effective July 16, dialing 988 has been designated as the new three digit dialing code that will route callers directly to the national suicide lifeline.

Update from DDD IOC Liaisons

Jeffrey Yamamoto informed the committee that Article 9 has not come out as an official release. No information has been communicated to him on any changes that are or are not being made to it. Therefore "the old Article 9 is the law of the land", so to speak. **Keith Jansen** asked about a topic in proposed changes to Article 9 which permits the team to bypass the requirement of a Behavior Treatment Plan due the member being stable. **Jeffrey Yamamoto** explained, he believes this applies to members who are not behavioral and are stable in their medications dosages. The old BP is utilized and an extension is filed.



Jeffrey Yamamoto informed the committee that the Quarterly meeting is coming up on July 20, next Wednesday. If you can make it and/or want to attend, let Jeffrey know and he will send an invitation out.

Michelle Rademacher DDD Liaisons have uploaded batches of IRs for review since the last meeting on June 28 and July 6. We will also upload a batch for review today. IRs being redacted currently are May 22 - 28. Responses to IOC IR questions have been received from DDD DS Quality. Michelle states she will disseminate today. Michelle had a question for the committee: Do you prefer receiving responses via excel sheet or would you prefer a google sheet uploaded to the district's shared drive? Committee members requested DDD quality responses be provided in Excel format with IR numbers included for referencing.

Michelle Rademacher shared that it has been discussed and moving forward, she will be the primary Liaison for District South IOC.

Discussion, Review, and Possible Action on Committee Membership

Keith Jansen updated the committee to inform that **Chere Solorzano** has withdrawn from the committee. Per guidelines the vice chair moves up to the chair position. He stated that in his opinion the committee could wait until Mario and Genevieve are present to vote for a vice chair. The committee members agreed.
